The successful Bidder will be required to execute a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract, issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi.

Each Bidder shall have a Certificate of Responsibility as required by the laws of the State of Mississippi to bid on contracts for public projects in which the bid price exceeds \$50,000.00. Each Bidder shall show on the outside of the envelope containing his bid: his current Certificate of Responsibility number and expiration date, or if applicable, a statement certifying that the bid enclosed does not exceed \$50,000.00 for a public project; his name; and the name of the Contract for which the bid is submitted. Failure to show these items on the outside of the envelope containing the bid will result in the bid being returned to the Bidder unopened

No Bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of ninety (90) days after date of actual bid opening, without Owner's consent.

The Tunica County Utility District reserves the right to reject any or all bids received; to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received; and to accept any bids that are deemed most favorable to the Tunica County Utility District.

Minority and women's business enterprises are solicited to bid on this contract as prime contractors and are encouraged to make inquiries regarding potential subcontracting opportunities, equipment, material and/or supply needs.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this invitation for bids are expected to be funded in whole or in part by anticipated funds from the US Department of Agriculture, Rural Development.
