

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

Under Title I, Part A, of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, low achieving, disadvantaged students attending schools that do not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) are identified for school improvement. The intent of this proposal is to provide job embedded professional development and on-site consultation for a Title I school that is designed to increase academic success of students in a low performing school. These services shall be provided to the Kemper County Schools during the 2014-2015 school year. Vendors may elect to submit proposals for the requested services at West Kemper Elementary.

These services will include Professional Development and Training for Administrative and Instructional Staff.
