Each Bidder must deposit with this bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project and that the Contractor must

ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or natural origin. Also, bidders must abide to the Federal Housing and Urban Development's Section 3 Regulation (24 CFR 135).

Minority and Women's business enterprises are solicited to bid on this contract as prime contractors and are encouraged to make inquiries regarding potential subcontracting opportunities, equipment, material and/or supply needs.

No Bidder may withdraw the bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Simultaneously with the delivery of the executed contract, the Contractor shall furnish surety bonds subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

All applicable laws, ordinances and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout.

Award will be made to the lowest responsible, responsive Bidder.
