

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE is hereby given that the City of Brookhaven, Mississippi, will receive written sealed bids until the hour of **2:00 pm** local time on **Tuesday, November 7, 2017** at the office of the City of Brookhaven located at 301 S First Street, Brookhaven, MS 39602 (601-833-1414) for the furnishing of all labor and materials, and for performing all activities specified in the Contract Documents, for the construction of the **Wood Street Drainage Improvements**.

The project includes the **Removal of and replacement of concrete drainage ditch**. The Contract Time will be **Sixty (60)** consecutive calendar days, and the liquidated damages will be **\$200** per consecutive calendar day thereafter.
