POSITION: Psychiatrist (Contract Worker)

WORK LOCATION: Newton

CONTRACT TERM: July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018

MINIMUM PAY: \$125.00 per Hour/\$200.00 flat fee per month for preceptor services/No Benefits

RESPONSIBILITIES: Provide psychiatric care, including pre-scheduled admissions, evaluations, psychiatric consultation, management, and discharging of such clients/patients. Contractor will provide such services at the Central Mississippi Residential Center one (1) day a week with a schedule to be mutually agreed upon by Contractor and Central Mississippi Residential Center's Director for a minimum of eight (8) hours per day and not to exceed twelve (12) hours per day. This coverage will be provided via on-site visits and thru phone consultation concerning client/patients; telemedicine is also an available option for consultation. Discharge summaries and chart deficiencies will be completed in the timeframes set forth in the Central Mississippi Residential Center Bylaws and Rules and Regulations. The Contractor will also provide preceptor services for CMRC's nurse practitioners, as well as other administrative duties as jointly agreed upon by the Contractor and Central Mississippi Residential Center's Director.

QUALIFICATIONS: **EXPERIENCE/EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Education:

Graduation from an accredited school of medicine with a Medical Doctor (MD) or Doctor of Osteopathy (DO) degree, or graduation from a foreign medical school and certification by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) or equivalent;

AND

Successful completion of a psychiatry residency program which is accredited by either the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) or the American Osteopathic Association (AOA), and

Certification/Licensure/Registration/Documentation as required below.

Certification, Licensure, and Registration:

Holds a current and unrestricted license to practice medicine as a physician in the State of Mississippi;

AND

Previous or current eligibility to become Board Certified, or is Board Certified in Psychiatry;

AND

Registered and certified by the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

Required Document(s):

Applicant must attach a copy his/her permanent license to practice medicine as a physician in the State of Mississippi.
