

**LEGAL NOTICE  
REQUESTS FOR STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS  
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES  
CITY OF WAVELAND**

The City of Waveland requests statements of qualifications from professional engineers to provide professional engineering services for the City of Waveland’s ‘Waveland Kiln Cutoff Road Safety Improvements Project’. RFQ’s shall include, but not limited to engineering design, bid, construction phase, and project close-out services for the City’s Waveland Kiln Cutoff Road Safety Improvements Project. This project is funded through State of MS. Senate Bill 2468 (Cap Ex) in the amount of \$1,000,000 (received) and \$3,679,510 (CDBG Grant) through the Community Development Fund – Economic Development Initiative (EDI), and Department of Housing and Urban Development (applied for) via Congressman Mike Ezell’s office. Selection will be based upon a specific review and evaluation process conducted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen and the evaluation criteria will be based upon demonstrated competence in the following areas: a) qualifications and familiarity of the project – 40 points; b) specialized experience – 15 points; c) technical competence – 20 points; and d) past performance – 25 points.

All proposers will be considered and ranked to determine the most highly qualified firm to provide the services solicited. Interviews with proposers may be held by the City of Waveland to finalize the selection of an engineer(s). The City will enter into contract negotiations with the most highly qualified firm to determine commercially reasonable terms and conditions based upon a clear understanding of the project scope, complexity, professional nature, and estimated value of services to be rendered. If a contract cannot be negotiated with the most highly ranked proposer, negotiations will continue with engineering firms in order of their ranked qualifications.

Sealed submissions of qualifications should be marked on the outside of the envelope “Professional Engineering Services – City of Waveland’s ‘Waveland Kiln Cutoff Road Safety Improvements Project’” and must include one original and six copies. A single copy of the submitting firm’s current rate schedule for professional services should also be included and placed in a separate sealed envelope marked “Current Rate Sheet.”

Each proposal submitted must follow the above-described guidelines and must be submitted to and received by the City of Waveland by 2:00 p.m. Central Time, Monday, December 16, 2024, to:
