NOTICE is hereby given that the Kosciusko Water & Light Commission, will receive written sealed bids until the hour of **5:30 PM** local time on **Tuesday, February 16, 2021** at the office of the Kosciusko Water & Light Commission located at 124 West Washington Street, Kosciusko, MS 39090 (662-289-1141) for the furnishing of all labor and materials, and for performing all activities specified in the Contract Documents, for the construction of the **Elm Street Well**.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 10:00 am local time, on Thursday, January 28, 2021, at the office of the Kosciusko Water & Light Commission at 124 West Washington Street in Kosciusko, Mississippi.

The project includes the **Installation of 850 GPM potable water well and abandonment of existing well**. The Contract Time will be **One Hundred Eighty (180)** consecutive calendar days, and the liquidated damages will be **\$250** per consecutive calendar day thereafter.
