

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids, in duplicate, will be received by Calhoun Health Services until 2:00 P.M., local time, on Tuesday, December 8, 2015, at the Conference Room in the Calhoun Health Services Nursing Home, Calhoun City, MS, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read for the following project:

Plans and specifications are now on file and may be examined or obtained from via www.mccartycompanyplans.com or at the Office of McCarty Architects, 533 West Main, Tupelo, MS 38804, upon deposit of Two Hundred (\$200.00) for each set to be refunded upon return of each complete set in good condition within fourteen (14) days after opening of bids.

Proposals shall be submitted on the blank bid form furnished with the specifications and must be accompanied by bid security in the form of Certified Check, Cashier's Check or acceptable Bid Bond, payable to Calhoun County in amount equal to at least five percent (5%) of the base bid; such security to be forfeited as liquidated damages, not penalty, by any bidder who may be awarded the contract but who fails to carry out the terms of the proposal, execute the contract and post performance bond in the form and amount within the time specified. Bids shall not be modified on the exterior of the sealed envelope.

All bids submitted in excess of \$50,000.00 by a prime or subcontractor to do any erection, building, construction, repair, maintenance or related work, must comply with Section 31-3-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, by having a current Certificate of Responsibility from the State Board of Public Contractors. The current Certificate of Responsibility Number shall be indicated on the exterior of the sealed bid envelope before it can be opened.

This project is partially funded through the Appalachian Regional Commission and is subject to all applicable laws, ordinances and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout.

In the letting of public contracts in the State of Mississippi, preference shall be given to resident contractors, and a non-resident bidder domiciled in a state having laws granting preference to local contractors shall be awarded Mississippi public contracts only on the same basis as the non-resident bidder's state awards contracts to Mississippi contractors bidding under similar circumstances; and resident contractors actually domiciled in Mississippi, be they corporate, individuals, or partnerships, are to be granted preference over non-residents in awarding of contracts in the same manner and to the same extent as provided by the laws of the state of domicile of the non-resident. When a non-resident contractor submits a bid for a public project, he shall attach thereto a copy of his resident state's current law pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for a period of sixty (60) days. Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids on any or all projects and to waive informalities.

A pre-bid meeting will take place on November 17, 2015 at 10:00 am in the Board Room (located in the Nursing Home), Calhoun Health Services, Calhoun City, Mississippi. All interested parties are encouraged to attend.
