**CONSTRUCTION OF CELL NO. 5/PHASE 1  
LOUISVILLE LANDFILL**

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Louisville, located at the City Hall, 200 South Church Avenue (P.O. Box 510) in downtown Louisville, Mississippi, 39339 until 10:00 a.m., Local Time, Friday, September 2, 2016 for supplying all labor and materials (as specified) necessary for construction of Cell No. 5/Phase 1.

Sealed bids may be delivered by hand to the address above, Attention: Babs Fulton, City Clerk, or sealed bids may be sent by Certified Mail to the same. The Contractor is fully responsible for the timely delivery of sealed bids to the City of Louisville regardless of the method he choose for delivery.

The work generally consists of the following:

1. Installation of leachate collection and pumping systems;
2. Installation of approximately 6 acres 60 mil FML;
3. Clay liner and clay buffer construction;
4. Approximately 370,000 cubic yards unclassified excavation.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the Contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

Contract time shall be 180 consecutive calendar days from the effective date shown in the Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages will be assessed in the amount of \$2,000.00 for each consecutive calendar day the Work has not achieved Final Completion.

Special Damages: In addition to the amounts provided for liquidated damages, expenses and other losses, Contractor, in the event of such default, shall pay to the Owner the actual costs, expenses and other losses reasonably incurred by Owner.

Bidder must be qualified under Mississippi Law and show current Certificate of Responsibility issued by the Mississippi State Board of Public Contractors establishing his classification as to the value and type of construction on which he is authorized to bid.

Each Bid must be received in a sealed envelope which is marked in the lower left hand corner EXACTLY AS FOLLOWS:

Each Bidder shall write his Certificate of Responsibility Number on the outside of the sealed envelope containing his proposal.

Sealed proposals shall be submitted sealed and deposited with the Louisville City Clerk prior to the hour and date hereinbefore designated. No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Each Bidder must submit with his proposal a separate attachment stating his qualifications to perform the work. The Statement of Qualifications shall list past projects of similar size

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and nature, a list of references with name and telephone number, a list of key personnel who will perform the work, and other information supporting the bidder's qualifications. Bidder must also submit the enclosed questionnaire with his proposal.

Awarding public contracts to non-resident Bidders will be on the same basis as the non-resident bidder's state awards contracts to Mississippi Contractors bidding under similar circumstances. In order to ensure that Mississippi's so-called Golden Rule is followed state law requires a non-resident bidder to attach to his bid a copy of his resident state's current laws pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors.

Each Bidder must deposit with his proposal, a Bid Bond or Certified Check in an amount equal to five percent of his bid, payable to the City of Louisville, as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested, by the City of Louisville. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Payment Bond and Performance Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the contract amount.

Contract Drawings, Contract Specifications, Instructions to Bidders and Bidders Proposal forms are on file and open to public inspection in the office of the City Clerk, City of Louisville, Mississippi and in the office of Neel-Schaffer, Inc. Copies of the Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Contract Drawings and Contract Specifications (with the exception of the Mississippi Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction) may be procured at the office of the Engineer between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., Local Time, Monday through Friday, upon payment of \$150.00 for each set, which will not be refunded.
