The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County, Mississippi, will receive bids for intersection improvements and signalization of Lemoyne Boulevard and Brittany Avenue in Jackson County, Mississippi, for a total project length of approximately 0.1 miles, Federal Aid Project No. STP-9186-00(003)LPA/106890-701000 **no later than 12:00 p.m. Local Time, December 12, 2016**, at the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County, 2915 Canty Street, Suite R, Pascagoula, MS 39567. All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud at **1:00 p.m. Local Time, December 12, 2016**, at the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County Meeting Room, 2915 Canty Street, Pascagoula, MS 39567.

The work shall consist essentially of the following items:

Construction of a northbound right-turn lane, drainage inlet, sidewalk, milling of pavement, new asphalt, new striping, and a new traffic signal.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

The contract Documents are on file and may be examined during normal business hours at the following locations:

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check on a solvent bank or a Bidder’s Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price, payable to Jackson County as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested by the County. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

The proposal and contract documents in its entirety shall be submitted in a sealed envelope marked plainly,


