Sealed Bids for Pump Station Rehabilitation will be received by the City of Gulfport, at the Office of Procurement at 1410 24th Avenue, Hardy Building, 2nd Floor, Gulfport, MS 39501 until 10:00 a.m., local time on March 24, 2016, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project consists of the furnishing materials and labor to perform certain renovations, modifications and upgrades to the existing City of Gulfport sewage collection, pumping, and transportation systems. This work includes the construction of approximately 4,850 linear feet of gravity sewer mains (8" to 10" in diameter); 22 manholes; approximately 350 linear feet of 4"-diameter force mains; renovations for pumping stations, which may include but not be limited to: piping modifications, abandonment of an existing station, replacing valves and discharge piping, installation of bypass assemblies, construction of valve vaults, installation of guide rails for pump systems, replacement of existing wet well tops, application of interior protective coatings to wet wells and designated manholes; along with other associated work and restoration of all disturbed facilities.

This Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is A. Garner Russell & Associates, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 520 33rd Street, Gulfport, MS 39507. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above. Printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office either via in-person pick-up or via mail, upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The non-refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents is \$150.00 per set.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held on March 9, 2016 at 1:00 PM local time in the Engineering Conference Room, 4050 Hewes Avenue, Gulfport, MS 39507.

For bids exceeding \$50,000.00, Bidder must indicate his Certificate of Responsibility Number on the outside of sealed proposal as required by Mississippi Law. Effective July 1, 2010; Per MS Code 31-3-21(3); any bid submitted by a nonresident contractor which does not include the nonresident contractor's current state law pertaining to such state's treatment of nonresident contractors, shall be rejected and not considered for award. If no such law exists in the non-resident contractor's state, then the non-resident contractor may provide a statement to that effect.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. Lowest and best bid submitted will be the determining factor for contract award.
