Sealed bids and proposals for TOWN OF CENTREVILLE 700 GPM WATER WELL will be received by the Town of Centreville, MS at the Town Hall, 1 Municipal Drive, P.O. Box 578, Centreville, MS 39631 until 2 P.M. C ST, on August 9, 2016.

CONTRACT TIME: 180 CALENDAR DAYS

The work involves the installation of:

700 GPM water well, 420 feet deep with all associated piping and appurtenances.

This project is classified as Municipal and Public Works Construction. Only those contractors holding licenses in that classification may bid the project.

Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents may be examined without charge at Town of Centreville Town Hall, 1 Municipal Drive, Centreville, MS, at the office of the Consulting Civil Engineers: Jordan, Kaiser & Sessions, LLC, 279 Lower Woodville Road, Natchez, Mississippi 39120, Telephone: 601-442-3628. Hard copies, which are required in order to submit a bid, may be obtained from the Consulting Civil Engineers upon receipt of \$100.00, non-refundable.

Proposal form will be furnished with the Specifications. In order to be considered, proposal shall be submitted on the proposal form and shall be properly marked and addressed as directed in the Specifications.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the bidder's total proposal.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond in the amount of One Hundred Percent (100%) of the bidders contract price.

Awarding public contracts to non-resident Bidders will be on the same basis as the non-resident Bidder's state awards contracts to Mississippi Contractors bidding under similar circumstances. In order to ensure that Mississippi's so-called Golden Rule is followed, state law requires a non-resident bidder to attach to his bid a copy of his resident state's current laws pertaining to such states treatment of non-resident contractors.

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest and best bidder on the basis of published quantities, who is considered qualified by the Town of Centreville, MS.

Any contract awarded under this invitation for bids will be funded by the Mississippi Community Development Block Grant Program. Bidders shall comply with all of the requirements pertaining to the use of these funds. Neither the U. S. nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to invitation for bids or any resulting Contract. Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order Nos. 11,246 and 11,375 which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, and the Contract Work Hours Standard Act. Bidders must certify that they do not and will not maintain or provide for their employees any facilities that are segregated on base of race, color, creed, or national origin.

The Town of Centreville encourages bids from minority and women owned business enterprises as prime contractors, to the fullest extent possible.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Owner reserves the right to award the Contract to the lowest and/or best bid, to waive any informalities and to reject any and all bids.
