NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the VICKSBURG HOUSING AUTHORITY, VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI until 2:00 P.M. local time, on Thursday November 17th, 2016 at the main office located at 131 Elizabeth Cr., Vicksburg, Mississippi 39183. Small businesses, minority and women owned businesses are encouraged to respond.

The work for which these proposals are to be submitted consists of providing all permits, labor, tools, materials, equipment and supervision necessary for the performance of all operations incidental to the demolition and construction renovation at 106 Athens Dr., Vicksburg MS 39183 in a safe and orderly manner. All work shall be performed to the terms and conditions of the Request for Proposal. The RFP documents may be requested from El-Amin Bashir at (601-638-1661) or email at frontdesk@vicksburgha.org. The RFP Specification documents can be obtained at the VHA office for a nonrefundable fee of \$25 or overnight FedEx delivery for \$75. Delivery via email request is free of charge.

For bids in excess of \$50,000, the bid envelop shall contain on the exterior the Contractors Certificate of Responsibility number (NO EXCEPTIONS).

Proposals shall be prepared, addressed and submitted in compliance with detailed instructions as set forth in the Contract Documents.

All Contractors submitting bids must pre-register with the Vicksburg Housing Authority to ensure that all documents, addendums and other critical information related to the bid is received. Contractors may register by e-mail to: frontdesk@vicksburgha.org, or call the office and requesting registration. All contractors are encouraged to make a visual assessment and take measurements to confirm the scope of work. A pre bid conference will be held at the main office October 27th at 10 a.m.; non-mandatory attendance for bidders.

All contractors shall be required to comply with the equal employment, E-Verify and Section 3 requirements of the Federal Government. Contractors may withdraw a proposal either personally, by written request, email or by FAX at any time prior to the scheduled closing time of receipt of proposals. NO PROPOSAL SHALL BE WITHDRAWN FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY (30) DAYS subsequent to the opening of Proposals without consent of VHA.

Attention is called to the fact that wages not less than the rates as published by DOL Davis Bacon Wages and as set forth in the specifications must be paid on this Project.

The Authority is an EEO/ADA compliant employer and reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to award in part or in whole, or to reject any part of any bid, to waive any informality in any bid, or to re-advertise for all or part of the Work contemplated.
