Notice is hereby given that the City of Biloxi, Mississippi, will receive sealed bids at the Mayor's Office, City Hall, 140 Lameuse Street, second floor, **until 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 13, 2016**, for the following:

Pedestrian and Public Transit Access Improvements

Work on which proposals are invited consists of the following items:

Construction of a ten foot wide sidewalk on the north side of C.T. Switzer, Sr. Drive and construction of a five foot wide sidewalk on the south side of C.T. Switzer, Sr. Drive. The project will also include minor drainage upgrades. The planned sidewalks will tie into the existing CTA transit stops located on the north and south sides of C.T. Switzer, Sr. Drive. The intersection of C.T. Switzer, Sr. Drive and Walmart Lane will become a three-way stop with pedestrian cross walks. Location of said work is located between Debuys Road and Eisenhower Drive in Biloxi, Mississippi.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Special Provisions governing selection and employment of labor.

Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Special Provisions. Minimum wage rates for all other projects have been predetermined and set forth in advertised specifications.

The City of Biloxi, Mississippi hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award. The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

Work to be performed shall be in accordance with the "Mississippi State Highway Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, 2004", together with all amendments and/or

special provisions and/or addenda to the standards duly approved and adopted, unless otherwise noted in these specifications.

Copies of the plans, specifications and proposal documents are on file with the City of Biloxi Engineering Division which is located at 214-A Delauney Street, Biloxi, and may be examined without charge during regular business hours (7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Monday – Friday). Plans and specifications may be obtained from the City of Biloxi Engineering Division, 214-A Delauney Street, Biloxi, Mississippi upon payment of \$5 for a CD or \$100 for a printed set, none of which is refundable.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check on a solvent bank or a Bidder's Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price, payable to the City of Biloxi as bid security. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.
