A pre-bid conference for this project will be held at Columbia – Marion County Airport on Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at 1:00 PM.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check or bid bond made payable to Columbia – Marion County Airport.

Bids may be held by the Columbia – Marion County Airport Board for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved, as the Columbia – Marion County Airport Board may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bids received.

This project is subject to the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act, as amended. The Contractor is required to comply with wage and labor provisions and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor.
