ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

Sealed bids for COMFORT REVOLUTION ROOF RESTORATION, BELMONT, MISSISSIPPI will be received by the Tishomingo County Board of Supervisors, 1008 Battleground Dr., Iuka, Mississippi, 38852 , until 10:00 A.M. on July 1, 2016, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained by depositing \$50.00 for each set received at the office of Dean McRae Engineering, Inc., P.O. Box 573, 308 Grisham Street, Iuka, Mississippi, 38852. (662) 423-9104. *The deposit is non-refundable.*

The work shall consist of providing a Roof Coating Restoration System over 431,000 square foot facility , which includes sealing penetrations, connections, high bay walls, raised ridge, etc. , as well as providing a twenty-year labor and material warranty for the roof system. The above items are intended to show the general nature of the work. Actual bid items and quantities shall be as defined in the contract bid proposal.

Each bid submitted must be marked on the outside "Bid for COMFORT REVOLUTION ROOF RESTORATION". Any bid in excess of \$50,000 must contain on the outside of the envelope the contractor's current certificate of responsibility number, and no bid shall be opened or considered unless this number appears on the outside of the envelope or unless a statement is included on the outside of the envelope indicating that the bid enclosed does not exceed \$50,000.

In the letting of public contracts, preference shall be given to resident contractors, and a nonresident bidder domiciled in a state having laws granting preference to local contractors shall be awarded Mississippi public contracts only on the same basis as the nonresident bidder's state awards contracts to Mississippi contractors bidding under similar circumstances; and resident contractors actually domiciled in Mississippi, be they corporate, individuals, or partnerships, are to be granted preference over nonresidents in awarding of contracts in the same manner and to the same extent as provided by the laws of the state of domicile of the nonresident. When a nonresident contractor submits a bid for a public project, he shall attach thereto a copy of his resident state's current law pertaining to such state's treatment of nonresident contractors. Any bid submitted by a nonresident contractor which does not include the nonresident contractor's current state law shall be rejected and not considered for award.

This project is being funded by State Development Infrastructure (DIP) Grant funds and is subject to the rules and regulations thereof.

A satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an accepted Surety, a certified check, or bank draft payable to the Tishomingo County Board of Supervisors, on negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (at par value), shall be submitted with each bid in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid.

Bids will only be accepted from Bidders who are listed on the Plan Holders list, signifying that they have purchased a set of documents from the Engineer.

Bids may be held for up to 60 days from the date of opening for review of bids and qualifications of bidders prior to Contract award. The Tishomingo County Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.
