All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 10:00 A.M., on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2016 at the office of Cook Coggin Engineers, 701 Foote Street, Corinth, MS 38834. This Pre-Bid Conference is not mandatory.

The work consists of essentially of the following items:

Removal of existing Sidewalks and replacement with ADA Sidewalks, Ramps and Pedestrian lighting along the route.

The above general outline of feature of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the Contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing the selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal Aid Projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of the Department of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581, Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth on the Contract Provisions.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Corinth hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check on a solvent bank or a Bidder's Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price, payable to the City of Corinth as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested by the City. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

The proposal and contract documents in its entirety shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and deposited with the City Clerk, City of Corinth, 300 Childs Street, Corinth, MS.

Work to be performed shall be in accordance with the "Mississippi State Highway Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, 2004", together with all amendments and/or special provisions and/or addenda to the standards duly approved and adopted, unless otherwise noted in these specifications.

The attention of Bidders is directed to the provisions of Subsection 102.07 pertaining to irregular proposals and rejection of bids.
