Sealed bids for "REHABILITATE RUNWAY 16-34 AND RECONSTRUCT TAXIWAY, AIP PROJECT NO. 3-28-0026-012-2016, will be received by the Director of Public Works, or Appointed Designee for the City of Forest, until 10:00 AM (Central Time) on the 14th day of July, 2016, at City Hall, 120 South Davis Street, Forest, Mississippi 39074, at which time they will be secured and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The work is generally described as follows:

Rehabilitation of the runway and taxiway by means of crack sealing, P-632 rejuvenator, and pavement markings. There will be a 60'x40' section of the taxiway that will be completely reconstructed.

Bidders shall submit 3 original copies of their proposal in the sealed envelope for their bid.

Contract Time is 60 calendar days. Liquidated Damages in the amount of \$250 per calendar day will be assessed thereafter.

The Contract, if awarded, shall be awarded to the bidder with the lowest, best bid. The Owner reserves the right to select an alternate bidder to replace or substitute for the original bidder in the event the original bidder fails to comply with the Contract.

The work performed shall be in exact accordance with the Construction Plans, Technical Specifications (on file at the office of the said Owner), Proposals and Special Provisions, under the direct supervision and to the entire satisfaction of the Owner and in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi. All project related work will also have to be completed in accordance with current FAA guidelines for work in Airport Operational Areas and in secured airfield areas.

Contractors must be qualified under Mississippi Law and be registered with the State of Mississippi and as a licensed general contractor capable of performing the required work.

A pre-bid conference is planned for this project on June 30, 2016 at 1:00 PM at City Hall. It is strongly recommended that prospective bidders attend the pre-bid conference. Bids must be submitted on the Standard Form of Bid Proposal for that contract, and must include a Bid Bond or other acceptable bid guarantee in the amount of 5% of the bid. The successful bidder will be required to execute the Standard Form of Contract and Agreement. The Bidder shall guarantee to hold his bid(s) good and may not withdraw his bid(s) for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

This project is subject to the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act, as amended. The Contractor is required to comply with wage and labor provisions and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor.
