The City of Tupelo will receive bids for Eason Boulevard Overlay for the City of Tupelo, Federal Aid Project No., STP-0430-00(018)LPA 106678/701000 no later than 10:00 a.m., Local Time, Thursday September 4th, 2014 at City of Tupelo, Mississippi at City Hall, 71 East Troy St., 2nd Floor Finance Dept., Attn: Missy Shelton.

All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work shall consist essentially of the following items:

Construction of overlay and striping along approximately 9,541 feet of Eason Boulevard and all other related items of work to complete the project as show and specified in Contract Documents.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the Contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The Mayor and City Council hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

All documents required for bidding purposes may be obtained from Engineering Solutions, Inc. located at 1324 N. Veterans Blvd., Tupelo, MS 38804 upon payment of \$450.00 for each set, which will not be refunded.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check on a solvent bank or a Bidder's Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price, payable to the City of Tupelo as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested by the City. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

3. The proposal and contract documents in it's entirety shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and deposited with the City of Tupelo Finance Dept., Attn: Missy Shelton, prior to the hour and date above designated. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the date of actual bid opening, without Owner's consent.

Work to be performed shall be in accordance with the "Mississippi State Highway Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, 2004", together with all amendments and/or special provisions and/or addenda to the standards duly approved and adopted, unless otherwise noted in these specifications. The attention of Bidders is directed to the provisions of Subsection 102.07 pertaining to irregular proposals and rejection of bids.
