Sealed bids for the Hancock County Beach Restoration Project and other related work will be received by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors at 854 Highway 90, Suite A, Bay St. Louis, MS 39520, until 11:00 A.M., Local Time, on October 20, 2014, and then at said location publicly opened and read aloud.

Scope of Work: Restore beach to pre-disaster condition by screening approximately 67 acres of beach face. Retrieve 35,389 cubic yards of sand and place sand to restore designed pre-disaster profiles on two (2) beaches. Replace 22,728 cubic yards of sand to restore designed pre-disaster profiles on two (2) beaches.
