Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check or bid bond made payable to Hancock County Port and Harbor Commission.

Bids may be held by the Hancock County Port and Harbor Commission for a period not to exceed 120 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.
