





Proper seated posture is essential to feeling as good at the end of your day as you do at the beginning. We feel so strongly about helping you do your best work that we've built our game-changing PostureFit sacral support into the backrest of every ergonomic work chair since Aeron.

Healthy seated alignment starts at the base of your spine, or your sacrum. PostureFit sacral support prevents slouching, which can compress your discs and prevent spinal fluid from flowing through. Instead, you stay in a healthy seated position, keeping your blood and oxygen flowing and preventing back and neck pain. The only thing you need to focus on is the work at hand.

### Balanced Recline

Reclining in your chair should be as mindless as breathing. No one wants to have to work to sit back in their chair, or to maintain a seated reclined position.

Herman Miller's proprietary tilt technology is designed to mimic the natural movement and pivot points of your body, keeping you balanced, regardless of your size and stature, as you move from upright to reclined seated positions.

### Dynamic Support

The best work chairs fit you – they don't ask you to fit them. From the Pixelated Support in the Embody seat and backrest to the Pellicle suspension in Aeron, Herman Miller work seating features dynamic surfaces to conform to your unique shape and seated movements, eliminating pressure points and allowing blood and oxygen to flow, keeping you focused and alert.

Zoned support is built into the suspension backs of many of our work chairs, providing more support along your spine, where you need it most, and less along the edges of the back, where you need to be able to flex and turn.
