Separate and sealed Bids for the ***Site Development / West Prentiss County Industrial Park***, will be received by the Prentiss County Board of Supervisors and the Prentiss County Development Association at the Prentiss County Board of Supervisors Boardroom, Prentiss County Chancery Building, 101 North Main Street, Booneville, Mississippi, until **10:00 am**, on the **6th of October**, 2014, at which time all bids will be opened and read aloud.

All plan holders are required to have a valid email address for registration. The cost of the Bid documents is \$125.00. Bid documents are non-refundable and must be purchased through the website. The Contract will be awarded as an entire job and individual items will not be let for separate work.

The work consists of Clearing and Grubbing, Excavation and Embankments, and Erosion Control items of approximately 10 acres of site work and an access roadway along with the necessary storm water pollution prevention items and other related work in Prentiss County, within the corporate limits of Booneville, Mississippi.

A conditional or qualified bid will not be accepted. Award will be made based on the lowest and best bid.

Each bidder must deposit with this bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the information for bidders. All bonds must be counter signed by a Mississippi Resident Agent.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 120 days after the actual date of the opening.

Simultaneously with his delivery of the executed contract, the Contractor shall furnish surety bonds subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

All applicable laws, ordinances and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout.
