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Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Supervisors of Union County, Mississippi, at 109 East Main, New Albany, Mississippi, 38652, until 10:00 a. m., Monday, September 29, 2014, and shortly thereafter publicly opened for the construction of Hot Mix Asphalt Overlay, Grading, Drainage and Limestone Base for Newport Road, on approximately 0.452 miles of road in Union County, Mississippi, also known as Federal Aid Appalachian Access Highway Project No. APL-0073(26)B.
