Invitation: The Hancock County Port and Harbor Commission (HCPHC) is requesting information from qualified companies interested in providing **Commercial Lawn Maintenance** for approximately 1.5 miles on Highway 603 from the Bay St. Louis city limit line to immediately north of Stennis Airport Drive in Kiln, Mississippi. Firms with relevant experience and qualifications are encouraged to submit.

Scope of Services: The HCPHC is seeking the services of commercial lawn maintenance for a 1.5 mile portion of Highway 603. Proposals received after the date and time indicated will not be considered.
