

## Advertisement for Bids

Separate and sealed Bids for the ***Maintenance Slurry Seal***, will be received by Itawamba County, at the board room in the Itawamba County Courthouse in Fulton, MS, until 10:00 am, on August 3, 2015, at which time all bids will be opened and read aloud.

The Contract Documents may be examined at the Itawamba County Courthouse in Fulton, Mississippi. The Contract Documents may be obtained from the office of Cook Coggin Engineers, Inc., 703 Crossover Road, Tupelo, Mississippi, 38801 (662-842-7381). The cost for the Contract Documents will be \$100.00, which will not be refunded.

The Contract will be awarded as an entire job and individual items will not be let for separate work.

The work consists of the placement of a Maintenance Slurry Seal on approximately 10.3 miles of road in Itawamba County, Mississippi. All work shall conform to the Mississippi Standard Specifications for State Aid Road and Bridge Construction, latest edition.

A conditional or qualified bid will not be accepted. The award of this project will be made based on the lowest and best bid for that requested by Itawamba County.

Each bidder must deposit with this bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the information for bidders. All bonds must be counter signed by a Mississippi Resident Agent.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening.

Simultaneously with his delivery of the executed contract, the Contractor shall furnish surety bonds subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

All applicable laws, ordinances and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over the construction of the project shall apply to the contract throughout.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the site and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Contract Documents. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation in respect to this bid
