

NOTICE OF INVITATION FOR BID

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Ocean Springs, Mississippi until 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, October 14, 2015 for the following project:

Harbor Storm Water Management and Wetlands Restoration
CIAP Project No. MS.30.706
Located in Ocean Springs, Mississippi

Bids are invited for this project that will improve the natural drainage and aesthetics of the Ocean Springs Harbor area. The scope of work includes construction of cast-in-place concrete retaining walls, sidewalks, asphalt parking lot improvements, landscaping and swale cleanup.

All bids must be on file with City Clerk, located at Ocean Springs City Hall, 1018 Porter Avenue, Ocean Springs, MS 39564 no later than **2:00 P.M on Wednesday, October 14, 2015** and bids must be sealed. If a bid is submitted by mail, the post office address of the City Clerk is P.O. Box 1800, Ocean Springs, Mississippi 39566. Said bids will be opened and read aloud in the Board Meeting Room located at 1018 Porter Avenue, Ocean Springs, Mississippi 39564. Envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed to the City Clerk, 1018 Porter Avenue, Ocean Springs, Mississippi 39564 and designated as Bid for “**Harbor Storm Water Management and Wetlands Restoration / CIAP Project No. MS.30.706**”. Additionally, the current Certificate of Responsibility Number shall be indicated on the exterior of the sealed bid envelope before it can be opened.

All documents required for bidding purposes must be obtained from Seymour Engineering 925 Tommy Munro, Suite G, Biloxi, Mississippi 39532 upon payment of \$150.00 non-refundable fee. Bidders who submit a Bid must be a Plan Holder of record at the issuing office. Bids from Bidders who are not on the Plan Holders List may be returned as not being responsive.

A strongly recommended Pre-Bid meeting will be held at 10 a.m., September 30, 2015, in the Board Meeting Room at the City Hall, 1018 Porter Avenue, Ocean Springs, Mississippi.

A certified check or bank draft payable to the order of City of Ocean Springs, negotiable U.S. Government bonds (at par value), or a satisfactory Bid bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety, must be submitted in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid for:

All bids submitted in excess of \$50,000.00 by a prime or subcontractor to do any erection, building, construction, repair, maintenance or related work, must comply with Section 31-3-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, by having a current Certificate of Responsibility from the State Board of Public Contractors.

Resident contractors shall, in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi, be granted preference over non-residents in the award of the contract in the same manner and to the same extent as provided by the laws of the state of domicile of the non-resident. A non-resident contractor shall attach to his bid proposal a copy of his resident state's current law pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors. If the state of residence of the Contractor has no such law then a statement BY AN OFFICER OF THE COURT indicating *the State of (Name of State) has no resident Contractor preference law* shall be submitted with the Bid Form. Failure by a non-resident bidder to submit either the information herein shall disqualify Contractor's bid and same will not be considered. Any bid submitted by a nonresident contractor which does not include the nonresident contractor's current state law shall be rejected and not considered for award.

ALL BIDS SUBMITTED FOR \$50,000.00 OR LESS SHALL BE SO MARKED ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE SEALED BID ENVELOPE

The City of Ocean Springs reserves the right to reject any and all bids received and to award said bid in the best interest of the City. Bids may be held for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of the opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.
