Sealed Bids for the construction of the Water System Improvements will be received by the City of Houston, at the office of City Hall, 120 East Madison St., Houston, MS 38851, until 10:00 am on November 10th, 2015, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of constructing: Contract "A" – 250,000 Gallon Elevated Storage Tank, Contract "B" – 500 GPM Water Production Well, Contract "C" – Five (5) Diesel Driven Fire Pump Arrangements along with approximately 16,000 feet of 12" Water Line, and other miscellaneous items.

Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via standard delivery service. Expedited shipping service charges will be paid by the prospective Bidder. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bid security and other requirements shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the office of City Hall, 120 East Madison St., Houston, MS 38851, at 10:00 am on October 20th, 2015. A representative of any prospective bidder is strongly recommended to attend.

This project is financed in part by grant funding made available through the U.S. Department of Commerce – Economic Development Administration (EDA) and Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC). Bidders should take note of the EDA Contracting Provisions for Construction Projects, included in the bid specifications, which contain provisions specific to EDA and other federal provisions not normally found in non-federal contract documents.
