WASTEWATER PRETREATMENT FACILITY  
CERES INDUSTRIAL INTERPLEX

Notice is hereby given that the Warren County Port Commission will receive sealed bids for the construction of a wastewater pretreatment facility at the Ceres Industrial Interplex. Bids will be received at the office of the Warren County Chancery Clerk, located at 1009 Cherry Street, Vicksburg, Mississippi 39180 until **11:30 A.M.** local time on **December 19, 2014**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Award will be made to the lowest, best and most responsive and responsible bidder.

The wastewater pretreatment facility shall consist of preliminary screening, pumping, a 160,000 gallon equalization tank with mixer, rapid mix chamber, flocculation chamber, settling tank, sludge tank and other appurtenant components such as water piping, chemical storage and feed systems, air compressor, process piping and electrical and control systems. The physical/chemical treatment components will be housed in a 2,400 SF concrete block building.

A certified check or bank draft drawn on a solvent bank, payable without condition to Warren County, Mississippi, or a bid bond of an amount not less than (5%) of the base bid amount shall be submitted with each bid as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into, and the performance of the contract properly secured.

All contractors responding to this advertisement for bids must comply with all applicable requirements of Chapters 3 and 5 of Title 31 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as

amended, including, but not limited to, the requirements relative to holding a Certificate of Responsibility and payment of a special privilege tax both items administered by the Mississippi State Board of Public Contractors. The successful bidder must furnish performance and payment bonds in the amount of the contract, pursuant to the requirements of Section 31-5-51 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of forty five (45) days after the scheduled date and time of the opening of bids without the written consent of the County. Within the limitations of the state law, the County reserves the right to reject any or all bids received, to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received, or to accept any bid that is deemed most favorable to the County.
