Specifications for sheeting materials:

Field performance requirements:

3M Scotchlite-3870 sheeting processed and applied to sign blank materials in accordance with sheeting manufacturer's recommendations, shall perform effectively for the number of years stated in the table of this specification. The retro-reflective sheeting will be considered unsatisfactory if it has deteriorated due to natural causes to the extent that: (1) the sign is ineffective for its intended purpose when viewed from a moving vehicle under normal day and night driving conditions; or (2) the coefficient of retro-reflection is less than the minimum specified for that sheeting during that period listed in the following table.

For screen printed transparent colored areas on white sheeting, the coefficients of retro-reflection shall not be less than 70% of the values for the corresponding color in the above table.

All measurements shall be made after sign cleaning according to sheeting manufacturer's recommendations.

Sheeting manufacturer's replacement obligation:

Where it can be shown that retro-reflective traffic signs with 3M Scotchlite-3870 sheeting supplied and used according to the sheeting manufacturer's recommendations have not met the performance requirements; the sheeting manufacturer shall cover restoration costs as follows for sheeting shown to be unsatisfactory during:

1. The entire ten years; the sheeting manufacturer will replace the sheeting required to restore the sign surface to its original effectiveness.
2. In addition, during the first seven years; the sheeting manufacturer will cover the cost of restoring the sign surface to its original effectiveness at no cost to the using agency for materials and labor.
3. Section E refers to traffic faces for school signs – fluorescent yellow green (FYG)

Hold harmless: contractor agrees that it will, and hereby does, indemnify, defend and hold harmless city of Gulfport from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, costs and expenses of every kind and nature, including court costs and attorney fees and claims for damages resulting from or arising out of any infringement claim or claim of bodily injury, death or damage to real or tangible personal property caused by contractor and/or its partners, principals, agents, employees or subcontractors in the performance of this contract. City of Gulfport will notify the contractor in writing of any claim to be indemnified hereunder, of which city has knowledge, and contractor in turn will promptly notify city of any such claim. Contractor shall, at its sole expense, control the defense of such suit to the extent allowed by Mississippi law. The parties agree to cooperate with one another in the defense of any such matter.

Any request for price increase during the term of contract will be rejected. Should this rejection result in the cancellation of the contract, the vendor shall be removed from the qualified bidders list for twenty-four (24) months.

If adverse conditions exist industry wide, modifications to disqualifications may be made as circumstances warrant.

The City reserves the right to request from the vendor an extension of this contract for a second term of twelve (12) months, commencing January 1, 2017, with all prices remaining constant.
