- A. Your firm is invited to submit an offer under seal to Owner for closure of Vanceleave High School Lagoon at the Central Office, located at 4700 Colonel Vickrey Rd., Vanceleave, MS 39565 before 2 pm local standard time on the 16th day of May, 2016, for the following project:
- B. Project Description: Closure of the existing Vanceleave High School Lagoon. Closure activities will include removal of the wastewater by means of pumping the wastewater to the existing pump station near the Vanceleave High School, removal of sludge and hauling for disposal at a permitted landfill or land application facility, demolition of miscellaneous utilities and equipment, as well as the filling of the lagoon using existing berm material and establishing permanent vegetation.
- C. Bids will be opened publicly at 5 pm on the same day bids are received at the same location, during the Jackson County School Board meeting.
- D. Bid Documents for a Stipulated Price contract may be obtained from the office of the Design Professional upon receipt of a nonrefundable deposit, by cash or check, in the amount of \$50.00 for one set via CD in PDF format.
- E. Bidders will be required to provide Bid security in the form of a Certified Check or Bid Bond of a sum no less than 5 percent of the Bid Amount; such security is to be forfeited as liquidated damages, not penalty, by any bidder who fails to carry out the terms of the offer. The Bid Bond, if used, shall be payable to the owner. Bid security must be provided in the sealed envelope along with the bid.
- F. Refer to other bidding requirements described in Document 002113 - Instructions to Bidders and Document 003100 - Available Project Information.
- G. Bidders are required to complete Bid Form 004100.
- H. Your offer will be required to be submitted under a condition of irrevocability for a period of sixty (60) days after submission.
- I. The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers.
- J. Successful bidder will be required to provide a 100% Performance & Payment Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to do business in the state of Mississippi within ten (10) days of bidder being notified of the award of contract.
- K. **CERTIFICATE OF RESPONSIBILITY:** All bids submitted in excess of \$50,000 by a prime or subcontractor to do any erection, building, construction, repair, maintenance or related work, must comply with Section 31-3-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, by having a current Certificate of Responsibility from the State Board of Public Contractors. The current Certificate of Responsibility Number shall be indicated on the exterior of the sealed bid envelope before it can be opened. **ALL BIDS SUBMITTED FOR \$50,000 OR LESS SHALL BE SO MARKED ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE SEALED BID ENVELOPE.**

- L. RESIDENT CONTRACTORS: Resident contractors shall, in accordance with laws of the State of Mississippi, be granted preference over non-residents in the award of the contract in the same manner and to the same extent as provided by the laws of the state of domicile of the non-resident. A non-resident contractor shall attach to his proposal a copy of this resident state's current law pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors. Any bid submitted by a nonresident contractor which does not include the nonresident contractor's current state law shall be rejected and not considered for award.
