Mr. Kesterman:

I am writing concerning your questions about the State Veterans Affairs Board's Food Service RFP. I have answered your questions below. Please be advised that both your questions and SVAB's answers will be shared with all other potential vendors.

1. Just to confirm, TB testing and Background Finger Prints will still be done at the facility which will then be invoiced back to the vendor?

Yes.

2. Page 8 states a full-time dietitian is required at each facility but on page 14 it states that the registered dietitian is required to work a minimum of 20 hours per week, just wanted clarity on the RFP requirement.

Yes, contrary to what is stated on page 14, the SVAB will require a full time dietitian.

3. On page 5 the RFP states that meal service will be available in the cafeteria for all three meals, is this a requirement 7 days a week?

Yes, meal service will be available in the cafeteria for all three meals seven days a week.
