

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County, Mississippi, will receive written sealed bids until the hour of 11:00 a.m. local time on Friday, June 24, 2016, at the office of the Chancery Clerk of Jefferson County, MS located at 1483 Main Street, Fayette, MS 39069 (601-786-3021) for the furnishing of all labor and materials, and for performing all activities specified in the Contract Documents, for the construction of the **2016 CDBG County Road Rehab Project** .

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 11:00 a.m. local time, on Friday, June 17, 2016, in the board room of the Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County, MS.

The project includes the **mix, shape, and compact, crushed limestone, and DBST paving**. The Contract Time will be **(180)** consecutive calendar days, and the liquidated damages will be **\$200** per consecutive calendar day thereafter.

Plans, contract documents and proposal forms are on file for public inspection in the office of the **Chancery Clerk of Jefferson County, 1483 Main Street, Fayette, MS 39069**, and in the office of the **Engineer, WGK, Inc., 204 W Leake St, Clinton, MS 39056 (601-925-4444)**. One copy of the contract documents and plans may be procured from WGK, Inc., PO Box 318 Clinton, MS 39060, upon payment of \$150 none of which is refundable.

Bids for this work will be accepted only under the name of the Bidder to whom the Contract Documents and Addenda, if any, have been issued by the Engineer. Bids received by bidders to whom the Contract Documents were not issued by the Engineer will be returned unopened.

State law requires a non-resident bidder to attach/include a copy of his resident state's current law pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors with their bid. Any bid submitted by a non-resident contractor which does not include the non-resident contractor's current state law shall be rejected and not considered for award.

Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968 requires that the County and contractors participating in CDBG projects give opportunities for job training and employment to lower income residents of the Section 3 area that is described as the **Jefferson County, MS**. Section 3 also requires that "to the maximum extent feasible" contracts for work in connection with Section 3 covered projects be awarded to business concerns that are located in or owned in substantial part by persons residing in the Section 3 area.

All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the hour of 10:00 a.m. local time on Monday, May 16, 2016, in the board room of the Board of Supervisors located at **1483 Main Street, Fayette, MS, 39069**, Bids will be considered by the **Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County, MS** at or before the next regular meeting thereof to be held within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of bids.

The **Board of Supervisors of Jefferson County, MS** reserves the right to waive any and all informalities in the bidding and to reject any and all bids.
