Canton Municipal Utilities (hereinafter referred to as "CMU") requests Qualifications and Cost Proposals for the removal and disposal of biosolids from CMU Wastewater facilities owned, operated and/or contracted by CMU. CMU will accept such Qualifications and Cost Proposals in the office of and addressed to the Office of Canton Municipal Utilities, 225 N Hargon Street, Canton, MS 39046, up to the hour of **2:30 p.m.** local time, June 30, 2016 at which time proposals will be opened publically and read aloud.

A **Mandatory** Pre-proposal is scheduled for June 16, 2016 at 10:00 A.M., local time in the Offices of CMU, located at 225 N Hargon Street, Canton, MS 39046. Attendance by all potential Contractors is required and for all other interested parties is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED**.

All proposals must include a proposal bond in the amount of 5% of the annual contract amount and consent of surety, agreeing that, in the event of the award of a contract, a performance bond will be furnished in the amount equal to 100% of the annual contract amount as outlined in the Specific Provisions. Proposers must include with their proposals a Certificate of Insurance showing coverage limits as outlined in Specific Provisions. The selected contractor shall procure, maintain, and keep this coverage in force at all times during the term of the contract at the contractor's sole expense.

The Request for Qualifications and Cost Proposals are available, at a cost of \$50, at the office of Waggoner Engineering, 143a LeFleurs Square, Jackson, MS 39211, at 601-355-9526 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM, local time. The general scope of the work includes the removal and disposal of biosolids generated at the Beatties Bluff Wastewater Treatment Facility (BBWWTF) by either landfill disposal or land application, with a bid option for Owner's consideration for the use of geotubes.

Each Proposal must be placed inside a sealed envelope or package, and the outside of the envelope or package must be marked with the wording: "Statement of Qualifications and Cost Proposals for Biosolids Removal and Disposal from the CMU Wastewater Facilities." The outside of the envelope or package must also state the name(s) of the Respondent. Statements of Qualifications received by the Board after the deadline will not be considered for any reason whatsoever. The rights and privileges to perform the Services will be awarded to the Respondent determined by CMU to be best qualified to perform the Services with Cost Proposals considered. Prior to making award, CMU may request certain Respondents to make presentations to the CMU Commission or review committee.

CMU reserves the right to reject any and all Statements of Qualifications and Cost Proposals for any reason at any time prior to execution of a contract and to waive any and all informalities and irregularities in the selection process. All proposal forms must be properly executed and submitted as part of the proposal. Canton Municipal Utilities is an equal opportunity employer.
