EXPAND TERMINAL APRON, PHASE IIIA AND IIIB

Sealed bids will be received by the Hancock County Port & Harbor Commission, located at 706 Highway 90, Waveland, Mississippi 39576, until 2:00 p.m., Local Time, August 3, 2016 then bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for supplying all labor and materials (as specified) necessary for the project entitled "Expand Terminal Apron, Phase IIIa and IIIB" at the Stennis International Airport.

The work generally consists of demolition of existing structures and associated utilities, site preparation, relocation of fencing and security gate, placement of soil cement base course (FAA Specification P-301), Hot Mix Asphalt Base Course (FAA Specification P-403), Hot Mix Asphalt Surface Course (FAA Specification P-401), Portland Cement Concrete Pavement (FAA Specification P-501), and installation of associated airfield lighting components at the Stennis International Airport in Kiln, Mississippi.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the Contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

Total contract time shall be 150 consecutive calendar days from the effective date shown in the Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages will be assessed in the amount of \$500.00 for each consecutive calendar day the Work has not achieved Final Completion.

A pre-bid conference is planned for this project on July 8, 2016 at 10:00 AM in the conference room at the Airport Terminal Building, 7250 Stennis Airport Road, Kiln, MS 39556

Special Damages: In addition to the amounts provided for liquidated damages, expenses and other losses, Contractor, in the event of such default, shall pay to the Owner the actual costs, expenses and other losses reasonably incurred by Owner.

Bidder must be qualified under Mississippi Law and show current Certificate of Responsibility issued by the Mississippi State Board of Public Contractors establishing his classification as to the value and type of construction on which he is authorized to bid.

Each Bidder shall write his Certificate of Responsibility Number on the outside of the sealed envelope containing his proposal.

Proposals shall be submitted in duplicate, sealed and deposited with the Hancock County Port & Harbor Commission prior to the hour and date hereinbefore designated. No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Each Bidder must submit with his proposal a separate attachment stating his qualifications to perform the work. The Statement of Qualifications shall list past projects of similar size and nature, a list of references with name and telephone number, a list of key personnel who will perform the work, and other information supporting the bidder's qualifications.

Awarding public contracts to non-resident Bidders will be on the same basis as the non-resident bidder's state awards contracts to Mississippi Contractors bidding under similar circumstances. In order to ensure that Mississippi's so-called Golden Rule is followed state law requires a non-resident bidder to attach to his bid a copy of his resident state's current laws pertaining to such state's treatment of non-resident contractors.

Each Bidder must deposit with his proposal, a Bid Bond or Certified Check in an amount equal to five percent of his bid, payable to the Hancock County Port & Harbor Commission, as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested, by the Hancock County Port & Harbor Commission. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Payment Bond and Performance Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the contract amount.

Contract Drawings, Contract Specifications, Instructions to Bidders and Bidders Proposal forms are on file and open to public inspection in the office of the Hancock County Port & Harbor Commission, 706 Highway 90, Waveland, Mississippi. Copies of the Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Contract Drawings and Contract Specifications (with the exception of the Mississippi Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction) may be procured at the office of the Engineer between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., Local Time, Monday through Friday, upon payment of \$100.00 for each set, which will not be refunded. Checks are to be made payable to the Engineer.

"Mississippi Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, 2004 Edition" as referred to herein, may be purchased from the Mississippi Department of Transportation. Minority and women's business enterprises are solicited to bid on this contract as prime contractors and are encouraged to make inquiries regarding potential subcontracting opportunities, equipment, materials and/or supply needs.

Bidder's attention is invited to Section 0100, Instructions to Bidders of the Contract Documents relative to Federal Statutory Contract Requirements.

This project is subject to the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act, as amended. The Contractor is required to comply with wage and labor provisions and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor.

The Hancock County Port & Harbor Commission hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

This project is subject to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation. The owner has established a contract goal for small business concerns owned and controlled

by qualified disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE). The bidder shall make and document good faith efforts, as defined in Appendix A of 49 CFR Part 26, to meet the established goal.
