ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Maintenance Dredging at USM Gulf Coast Research Laboratory – Halstead Campus will be received by USM, at the Halstead Campus Dining Hall until 2:00 p.m., local time on Wednesday, July 27, 2016, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of dredging and disposal of dredged material from the channel connecting the USM Harbor to Davis Bayou.

Bids will be received from a single prime Contractor. Bids shall be on a unit price basis, as indicated in the Bid Form.

This Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Brown, Mitchell & Alexander, Inc., 796 Vieux Marche, 2nd Floor, Biloxi, MS 39530, (228) 436-7612. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Thursdays between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 5:30 P.M. and Friday, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 12:00 P.M. (NOON), and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above.

Printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office either via in-person pick-up or via mail, upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The non-refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents is \$50 per set, payable to Brown, Mitchell & Alexander, Inc.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders.

For bids exceeding \$50,000.00, Bidder must indicate his Certificate of Responsibility Number on the outside of sealed proposal as required by Mississippi Law. Effective July 1, 2010; Per MS Code 31-3-21(3); any bid submitted by a nonresident contractor which does not include the nonresident contractor's current state law pertaining to such state's treatment of nonresident contractors, shall be rejected and not considered for award. If no such law exists in the non-resident contractor's state, then the non-resident contractor may provide a statement to that effect.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
