

**INVITATION FOR BIDS
CANTON, MISSISSIPPI
REPAIR OF DAMAGED STREETS AT SPECIFIED LOCATIONS**

Notice is hereby given that Canton Municipal Utilities Board of Commissioners will receive sealed bids at the Canton Municipal Utilities Service Center, located at 225 North Hargon Street, Canton, Mississippi 39046, until 10:00 A.M., September 30, 2016, for repair of “Specified Damaged Streets at 176 Specified Locations in the City of Canton, Mississippi”, together with all appurtenant work required to repair said damaged streets to the standards specified in these documents. The project will include base repair, excavation, backfilling, paving and all other work associated with the repair of the said streets at the specified locations.

Please note that there will be a pre-bid conference held on September 14, 2016 between the time of 10:00 and 11:00 AM, in the Canton Municipal Utilities Service Center Conference Room, located at 225 North Hargon Street, Canton, Mississippi 39046. Representatives from Canton Municipal Utilities and the Project Engineer’s Office will be on hand to answer questions related to this project.

All Bids must be sealed and must be marked on the outside of the envelope:

**“Bids – REPAIR OF DAMAGED STREETS AT 176 SPECIFIED
LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF CANTON, MISSISSIPPI”**

Each Bidder must deposit with his Proposal a Bid Bond or Certified Check in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of his Bid, payable to Canton Municipal Utilities, as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement if requested by Canton Municipal Utilities.

Bidders must be qualified under Mississippi Law and show Certificate of Responsibility issued by the Mississippi State Board of Public Contractors. Each Bidder shall write his Certificate of Responsibility Number on the outside of the sealed envelope containing his Proposal. No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The successful Bidder must provide both a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract upon execution of the Contract.

The Contract Time is Sixty (60) Working Days with a liquidated damages provision of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per calendar day thereafter.

The Canton Municipal Utilities Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Dated this the 19th day of July, 2016.
