ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Water & Sewer Improvements for the Learning and Wellness Commons at Tradition project will be received by the Harrison County Board of Supervisors, 1801 23rd Avenue, Gulfport, MS 39502 until 2:00 p.m., local time, on October 5, 2016, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of constructing an extension of an existing water and sewer system. Work will include installing approximately 375 linear feet of 12" water main, 2,500 linear feet of 8" water main, installing a sewer pump station and approximately 3,000 linear feet of gravity sewer.

Bids will be received from a single prime Contractor. Bids shall be on a unit price basis, with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Brown, Mitchell & Alexander, Inc., 796 Vieux Marche, 2nd Floor, Biloxi, MS 39530, (228) 436-7612. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Monday through Thursday, between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 5:30 P.M., and Friday, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 12:00 P.M. (noon), and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above.

Bidding documents are available on compact disc (as pdf files) for a non-refundable charge of \$75.00. Alternately, printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office either via in-person pick-up or via mail, upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The non-refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents is \$100.00 per set, payable to Brown, Mitchell & Alexander, Inc.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

The U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration is providing partial funding for this project (Federal ID / EDA No. 04-01-07048).

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders.

For bids exceeding \$50,000.00, Bidder must indicate his Certificate of Responsibility Number on the outside of sealed proposal as required by Mississippi Law. Effective July 1, 2010; Per MS Code 31-3-21(3); any bid submitted by a nonresident contractor which does not include the nonresident contractor's current state law pertaining to such state's treatment of nonresident contractors, shall be rejected and not considered for award. If no such law exists in the non-

resident contractor's state, then the non-resident contractor may provide a statement to that effect.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
