GENERAL – PART I

1.1 GENERAL: This Statement of Need defines the equipment specifications being requested to provide a trailer to support CRASHED DISABLED DAMAGED AIRCRAFT RECOVERY (CDDAR) at Columbus AFB, MS IAW TO 00-80C-1

PRODUCTS/TECHNICAL – PART II

2.1. Vendor shall provide one (1) enclosed trailer

2.1.1. Minimum salient characteristics:

2.1.1.1. Minimum length of 20 foot enclosed trailer with the capacity to hold at least 12,000lbs. Trailer will be equipped with an emergency group package containing a spare tire with rim compatible with trailer, back up alarm, rolling 3 ton jack, lug wrench, set of wheel chocks and three (3) each safety triangle emergency reflectors.

2.1.1.2. Heating and cooling package. Trailer shall have a minimum 13,500 BTU air conditioner, electrical heat minimum 9,000 BTU units, and with the required distributional ducting in the top of the trailer and thermostat controlled.

2.1.1.3 Electrical package shall contain minimum four (4) 110V external power outlets installed (two (2) on each side forward and rear of trailer) to power external equipment. The trailer will have minimum eight (8) 110V outlets installed throughout inside of the trailer at least four feet above floor level to power miscellaneous equipment. Trailer to have shop lights installed on ceiling to provide lighting throughout trailer. Provide electrical system that can be connected to commercial power or generator system to run all electrical requirements. All trailer electrical systems and wiring must meet the National Electrical Codes (NEC).

2.1.1.4 Generator system. Trailer shall have a mounted electrical start generator system on or near the tongue/A-Frame of the trailer to power all necessary power requirements to include electrical outlets, lights, and support the air conditioner/heating unit. The generator unit shall be covered to protect the unit from the environment.

2.1.1.3 Doors. The trailer shall have minimum of one personnel door on right side near the front of trailer and a heavy duty ramp at the rear of the trailer to allow access for recovery equipment.

2.1.1.4 Water tank. The trailer shall have a built-in water tank that holds at least 20 gallons of water and stand vertical inside front of the trailer. The water tank shall be plumbed to allow servicing and draining from outside of the trailer.

2.1.1.5 Trailer floor. The trailer floor shall have tie downs throughout the floor to enable loose items to be properly secured to the floor. Tie down will be at least twelve (12) inches from inside walls of trailer.

2.1.1.6 Jacks. The trailer shall have a heavy duty leveling system and an electrical hitch jack.
