

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

HEAVY EQUIPMENT BROKERAGE SERVICES

The City of Biloxi is seeking proposals from qualified heavy equipment brokers to provide services to sell a 1996 Emergency One H715 Hurricane Firetruck on behalf of the City of Biloxi. The selected firm will be required to provide services to locate a buyer for the above unit and provide all required advertisement information required to find a buyer for the above unit.

Firms or individuals proposing to furnish such professional services should submit a written proposal (an original plus two copies), which will be evaluated and ranked by a City Selection Committee on the basis of the following criteria to determine the best offer.

- 20% Qualifications and technical competence of staff to be assigned to the project;
- 20% Capacity of the firm or individual as defined by personnel resources and availability of qualified staff to complete the project within a reasonable timeframe;
- 20% Previous experience of the firm or individual working with municipalities;
- 20% Familiarity with applicable local and state regulations;
- 20% Brokerage commission.
