The Council of the City of Pascagoula, Mississippi, will receive bids for the construction of sidewalks, curb and gutter, crosswalks, and signage Eden Street, Lanier Avenue, and Spruce Street for a total project length of 0.587 miles, Federal Aid Project No. SRSP-0370-00(025) LPA/106706/401000 no later than 2:00 p.m., Local Time, (November 10, 2016), at City Hall located at 603 Watts Avenue, Pascagoula, Mississippi. All bids so received will be publicly opened and read aloud. The work shall consist essentially of the following items:

Removal of existing sidewalks, curb and gutter, replacement of curb and gutter, sidewalks, crosswalks, and signage that meet ADA requirements. All other related items of work required to complete the project as shown and specified in the Contract Documents.

The above general outline of features of the work does not in any way limit the responsibility of the contractor to perform all work and furnish all plant, labor, equipment and materials required by the specifications and the drawings referred to therein.

The attention of bidders is directed to the Contract Provisions governing selection and employment of labor. Minimum wage rates for Federal-Aid projects have been predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and are subject to Public Law 87-581 Work Hours Act of 1962, as set forth in the Contract Provisions.

The Council of the City of Pascagoula hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged and women's business enterprises will be afforded the full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The award of this contract will be contingent upon the Contractor satisfying the DBE/WBE requirements.

The bid documents are being made available online via original paper copy or electronically upon payment of \$175.00 per paper copy and \$75.00 per compact disc. The drawings bound in the bid

documents are photographic reductions of the original tracings. Full-scale drawings may be obtained (provided a set of reduced drawings and specifications has been purchased) for an additional \$90.00 per set. Cost includes shipping and handling for each set. The bid documents are non-refundable and must be purchased through the website. Return of documents is not required. All plan holders are required to have a valid email address for online registration. Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check on a solvent bank or a Bidder's Bond issued by a Surety Company licensed to operate in the State of Mississippi, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price, payable to the City of Pascagoula as bid security. Bidders shall also submit a current financial statement, if requested by the City.


The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount.

The proposal and contract documents in its entirety shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and deposited with the City Clerk's Office at 603 Watts Avenue, Pascagoula, Mississippi prior to the hour and date above designated.

Work to be performed shall be in accordance with the "Mississippi State Highway Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, 2004", together with all amendments and/or special provisions and/or addenda to the standards duly approved and adopted, unless otherwise noted in these specifications.

The attention of Bidders is directed to the provisions of Subsection 102.07 pertaining to irregular proposals and rejection of bids.
