Purpose:

Proposals are being sought by The Baldwyn School District for the purpose of evaluating various solutions to provide digital devices and resources in accordance with Baldwyn School Districts Digital Learning Initiative.

Background:

Baldwyn School District has developed a new and exciting Digital Learning Initiative, focused on enhancing academic learning through new technology resources. This 1:1 Digital Learning Initiative is on the leading- edge in our state and serves as a model for other School Districts throughout the Southeast. Our technology philosophy is based on a holistic approach where personalized, digital learning and technology skills are infused throughout the daily teaching and learning process.

As part of this initiative, all teachers and certified staff were issued state-of-the-art laptop computers and tablets for school and home. Teachers will use issued technology in conjunction pre-installed software programs and applications throughout the curriculum. 1. Scope of Work, Professional Development, and Technical Specifications:

2. Must provide warranties and professional services for all equipment.
3. Pricing must be good for up to 90 days.
4. Must provide a Tax-exempt dollar out lease.
5. 4 equal payments. Devices delivered in July, 2020. Payments begin September, 2020 and continue for 3 years after in September 2023.
