GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. **Definitions:** The term "vendor" as used herein and elsewhere in these Terms and Conditions shall be used synonymously with the term "successful bidder." The term "district" shall mean Pearl Public School District.
- 2. **Bid is Offer to Contract:** Each bid constitutes an offer to become legally bound to a contract with the district, incorporating the invitation to bid and the bidder's bid. The binding offer includes compliance with all terms, conditions, special conditions, specifications, and requirements stated in the invitation to bid, except to the extent that a bidder takes written exception to such provisions. All such terms, conditions, special conditions, and requirements will form the basis of the contract. The bidder should take care to answer all questions and provide all requested information, and to note any exceptions in the bid submission. Failure to observe any of the instructions or conditions in this invitation to bid may result in rejection of the bid.
- 3. **Binding Offer:** Each bid shall constitute a firm offer that is binding for ninety (90) days from the date of the bid opening, unless the bidder takes exception to this provision in writing.
- 4. **Bidder's Questions:** The Pearl School District Technology Department must receive questions about this invitation to bid in writing by the date indicated in the invitation to bid cover letter. The district will post answers to questions and/or other information concerning the invitation to bid in the form of an addendum on the district's website at <u>www.pearlk12.com</u>. It is the responsibility of the prospective bidder to check the website for any addenda issued for this invitation to bid.

- 5. **Bid Submission:** Submission will be via Reverse Auction, in accordance with Mississippi Reverse Auction laws. **The auction will begin at 10:00 AM Central Time, on Wednesday, January 11, 2023**. This will be conducted via a WebEx Meeting. All vendors who have registered their intent to bid, will receive an invitation to the meeting. Bidders may also attend the reverse auction in person and may call out their bid to the meeting host. Bids will be received through the chat function. A timer of 5 minutes will be given after each bid is received. The auction will last 30 minutes, or the timer runs out, whichever occurs first.
- 6. Bid Preparation Costs: The bidder shall bear all costs associated with preparing the bid.
- 7. More than One Bid: Do not submit alternate bids or options, unless requested or authorized by the district in the Invitation to Bid. If a responder submits more than one bid without being requested or authorized to do so, the district may disqualify the bids from that responder, at the district's option.
- 8. **Bid Corrections or Withdrawals:** The bidder may correct a mistake, or withdraw a bid, before the bid opens by sending written notification to the Chief Financial Officer. Bids may be withdrawn after the bid opening only with written authorization from the Chief Financial Officer.
- 9. **Defects or Irregularities in Bids:** The district reserves the right to waive any defect or irregularity in any bid received. In case of an error in extension of prices or totals in the bid, the unit prices shall govern.
- 10. **Prices Held Firm:** Prices quoted shall be firm for the period of the contract, unless otherwise specified in the bid. All prices for commodities, supplies, equipment, or other products shall be quoted FOB Destination, Pearl Public School District, or job site.
- 11. **Brand Name:** If items in this invitation for bid have been identified, described, or referenced by a brand name or trade name description, such identification is intended to be descriptive, but not restrictive and is to indicate the quality and characteristics of products that may be offered. Alternative products may be considered for the award if clearly identified in the bid. Items offered must meet required specifications and must be of a quality which will adequately serve the use and purpose for which intended.
- 12. Bidder Substitutions: Bidders offering substitutions or deviations from specifications stated in the invitation to bid, shall list such substitutions or deviations on the "Exceptions to Specifications" sheet provided, or on a separate sheet to be submitted to <u>kknuckles@pearlk12.com</u> before 10:00 AM Central Time, on Wednesday, January 11, 2023. The absence of such list shall indicate that the bidder has taken no exception to the specifications. The evaluation of bids and the determination as to equality and acceptability of products or services offered shall be the responsibility of the district.
- 13. **Samples:** When the district requires samples as part of the bid and vendor selection process, bidders must provide requested samples within the time allotted, and at no cost to the district unless otherwise specified. Any goods provided under contract shall conform to the sample submitted. The district will return samples only at the bidder's request, and at the bidder's expense, if they are not destroyed by testing.
- 14. **Non-Collusion:** By responding to this invitation to bid, the bidder represents that the bid is not made in connection with any competing bidder, supplier, or service provider submitting a separate response to this invitation to bid and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud.

- 15. **Bid Evaluation:** Award will be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, taking into consideration payment terms, vendor qualifications and experience, quality, references, any exceptions listed, and/or other factors deemed relevant in making the award. The district may make such investigation as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform, and the bidder shall furnish to the district all information and data for this purpose as the district may request. The district reserves the right to reject any bid item, any bid, or all bids, and to re-advertise for bids.
- 16. Payment Terms and Discounts: The District's standard payment terms are Net 45.
- 17. **Delivery and Installation:** Vendor to deliver, set in place and completely install. Successful bidder shall also remove all packing, crating, etc., and leave site free of any job-related refuse or materials.
- 18. **Delivery Failures:** If the vendor fails to deliver contracted goods or services within the time specified in the contract or fails to replace rejected items in a timely manner, the district shall have authority to make open-market purchases of comparable goods or services. The district shall have the right to invoice the vendor for any excess expenses incurred or deduct such amount from monies owed the vendor. Such purchases shall be deducted from contracted quantities.
- 19. Substitution of Contracted Items: The vendor shall be obligated to deliver products awarded in this contract in accordance with terms and conditions specified herein. If a vendor is unable to deliver the products under the contract, it shall be the vendor's responsibility to obtain prior approval of the ordering agency to deliver an acceptable substitute at the same price quoted in the vendor's original bid. In the event any vendor consistently needs to substitute or refuses to substitute products, the district reserves the right to terminate the contract or invoke the "Delivery Failures" clause stated herein.
- 20. **Termination for Cause:** The district may terminate the contract for cause by sending written notice to the vendor of the vendor's default in the performance of any term of this agreement. Termination shall be without prejudice to any of the district's rights or remedies by law.
- 21. **Termination for Convenience:** The district may terminate the contract for its convenience at any time with 10 days' written notice to the vendor. In the event of termination for convenience, the district will pay the vendor for services performed. The district will compensate partially for completed performance based upon a signed statement of completion submitted by the vendor, which shall itemize each element of performance completed.
- 22. Force Majeure: Each Party shall be excused from performance for any period and to the extent that it is prevented from performing any obligation or Services, in whole or in part, as a result of causes beyond the reasonable control and without the fault or negligence of such Party and/or its subcontractors. Such acts shall include without limitation acts of God, strikes, lockouts, riots, acts of war, epidemics, governmental regulations superimposed after the fact, fire, earthquakes, floods, hurricanes, tornados, or other natural disasters ("Force Majeure Events"). When such a cause arises, Vendor shall notify the District immediately in writing of the cause of its inability to perform, how it affects its performance, and the anticipated duration of the inability to perform. Delays in delivery or in meeting completion dates due to Force Majeure Events shall automatically extend such dates for a period equal to the duration of the delay caused by such events, unless the District determines it to be in its best interest to terminate the Agreement.

Mississippi. The parties agree to submit to the jurisdiction in Rankin County, Mississippi, and further agree that any cause of action arising under this agreement shall be required to be brought in the appropriate venue in Pearl Public School District.
