Commodity or commodities to be purchased (manufacturer, model, description):

Model: RS-420-Q X-ray Irradiator system manufactured by Rad Source Technologies, Inc.

The need to be fulfilled by this item(s) and why it is the only one that can meet the specific needs of the department:

This X-ray Irradiator system is required for National Center for Natural Product Research (NCNPR) to fulfill contractual requirements for manufacturing and irradiating dried cannabis plant materials for research studies. The rotating "Ferris-wheel" type of cannisters provides for uniform X-ray exposure without tumbling the materials. Other manufactures use rotating drums that tumble and mix the materials, a method not thoroughly proven effective for reducing the bioburden to the levels required by NCNPR. Rad Source is the only manufacturer using the patented Quastar x-ray technology which is a transmission x-ray source designed for irradiation treatment. The standard point source used by others was designed for imaging. The Quastar x-ray emitter has the highest available dose rate, unmatched dose uniformity, and the most efficient use of energy available in a cabinet x-ray device.

If after a review of the submitted notice and documents, UM determines that the commodity in the proposed sole source request can be provided by another person or entity, then UM will withdraw the sole source certification and submit the procurement of the commodity to an advertised competitive bid or selection process.

If UM determines after review that there is only one (1) source for the required commodity, then UM will appeal to the Public Procurement Review Board for approval to purchase.
